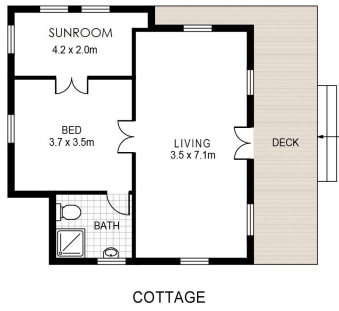
With council approval as a B&B, the cottage is perfect for guests or an extra income.
